Complaints and compliments can be made by phoning our office, writing to us, or through our website.

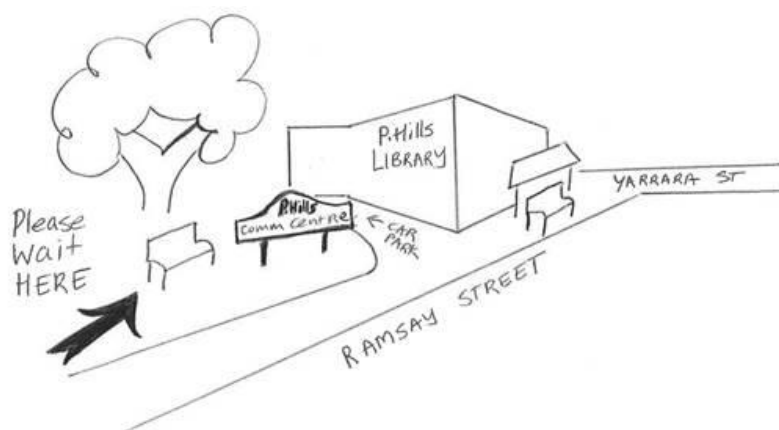
We will take the scenic route on the way to the venues if time and traffic permit!
