




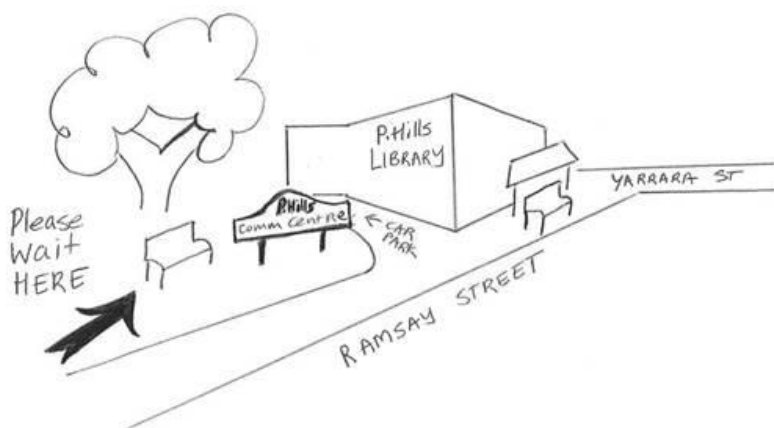
Your safety and comfort is our number ONE priority.
