Shopping shuttles

Our 1-hour visits help with picking up essential items and cover West Pymble, East Lindfield, Turramurra, Berowra and Mt Ku-ring-gai, Westleigh and Thornleigh.

A 2-3 hour alternative takes customers to St Ives Village, Gordon, Hornsby Westfield, Macquarie Centre, Carlingford Court and Cherrybrook Village.

Medical appointments

We provide transport for specific health-related appointments at Hornsby Hospital's Bernard Curran Unit.

Our drivers will also help customers get to and from doctors and specialists—within local or neighbouring areas. For appointments further afield, we may arrange transport using HKCT taxi vouchers.

Group outings

Our expertise extends to scenic destinations (near or further afield) and we offer a program of visits to museums, galleries, cafes, clubs, pubs, picnics and nurseries.

HKCT's friendly, professional staff are waiting to assist with registering new customers, confirming eligibility for any subsidies, explaining our affordable non-subsidised rates, and (of course) taking bookings.

We have wheelchair hoists to cater for clients who are non-ambulant from their mobility device.

All customers please note: embarkation guidance is offered, but not manual lifting.



And for everyone's peace of mind, our drivers have a Bus Authority Licence, first aid certification and have been security-checked.

How to become our customer

HKCT's transport services are available to eligible residents living within the areas designated as Hornsby Shire and Ku-Ring-Gai Council.

Qualified for CHSP?

We assist with subsidised transport if you are over 65 years of age, or over 50 years age if an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander, and have qualified for CHSP transport service.

To qualify for CHSP transport, please first **register with My Aged Care:**

Under 65?

If you are under 65 years of age, you may qualify for other transport programs such as offered by the Community Transport Program.

HCP and non-subsidised

If you have qualified for a Home Care Package or wish to take advantage of our affordable, non-subsidised rates, please call us to discuss the criteria and pricing.

How to use our services

Once you are registered as an HKCT customer, give us 72 hours advance notice of needing transport—and leave everything else to us.



Call 9983 1611 and let's discuss where and when you would like to go.



CHSP Contribution Framework: our fees are modest and a contribution is required. Arrangements may be made for those unable to contribute.

Important: paying with a credit/debit card while booking removes the worry of handling cash or having the correct amount.



Cancellation: please tell us at least 24 hours prior to pick up or a fee may be payable.
