Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Community College in Hunter Street Hornsby are NSW Govt & Telstra funded to run training sessions in small class sizes for learners over the age of 60. They have a wide variety of training guides for beginners and intermediate users, starting with introductions to computers, tablets, the internet, email, social media and on-line shopping through to more detailed sessions on these and more ... apps, your seniors card, managing digital assets and sharing photos on line. Even video calling and advanced on-line shopping!

They also have a digital library, so learners can borrow a tablet for up to 3 weeks to practice digital skills and get in the habit of staying connected with family and friends.

Then there’s a Be Connected program where you can access one-on-one mentoring support, provided by volunteers.
